


## ABOUT THE COLLECTION




















## Ekam

Technique: Jacquard Thickness: 5 mm




Ekam, meaning oneness, embodies harmony through the Pataka mudra, known as the King of Mudras. The repeating, interlaced hands mirror a seamless rhythm — where gestures flow into one another without beginning or end. Symbolizing unity and balance, the rug becomes a meditative space where movement and meaning merge as one









### Karunika

Karunika, meaning compassionate, celebrates the Pataka mudra, the King of Mudras in Indian classical dance. The design frames this gesture of blessing, dignity, and protection into an embracing border, while the calm central field invites openness and storyteling. A rug that shelters with grace, it transforms space into a stage of compassion and presence









## Kathanika


Kathanika, meaning storyteler, captures the poetry of Indian classical dance through sweeping mudras woven into the surface. From the bee and lotus to gestures of offering and ceremony, each motif is a verse in a larger story. The rug becomes a living performance—where devotion, grace, and rhythm flow into art




Mayuram, named after the Sanskrit word for peacock, celebrates the elegance and storyteling power of Indian classical dance. Framed by mudras that evoke nature, feathers, and monsoon drama, the rug narrates the peacock's dance, graceful, regal, and alive with emotion. A symbol of the dancer's own artistry, it transforms tradition into movement and beauty




Nadanam, meaning the dance, honors the cosmic rhythm of Nataraja, Shiva as the Lord of Dance. The rug embodies creation, preservation, and dissolution, the eternal cycles of the universe, transforming any space into a sacred stage where the rhythm of life and dance flows beneath every step











### Nattyam






Nattyam, meaning dance, celebrates the storyteling power and sacred rhythm of Indian classical movement. The rug is framed by arches reminiscent of temple niches, each window offering a glimpse into a world of silent poetry. Its three mudras, Katakamukha, Kapitha, and Bhramara, trace the arc of the dancer's journey: from preparation and adornment, through devotion and commitment, to the ecstatic exploration of movement and expression. Nattyam transforms any space into a sacred stage, where gesture, rhythm, and narrative flow together in a continuous, living performance









## Prabhavam




Prabhavam, meaning radiance and origin, envisions mudras as rays of energy flowing from the dancer's heart. A red circle at the center symbolizes the core of being, while twelve gestures radiate outward like a cosmic mandala echoing the first dance of Shiva, the origin of dance itself. The rug celebrates stilness transforming into stories that iluminate the world











## Samyuktha

Samyuktha reimagines classical dance mudras through a contemporary lens. The rug fragments a single hand gesture across a grid, inviting the viewer to actively piece together its movement. Inspired by tiled art and the rhythm of repetition, it transforms a solitary gesture into a visual narrative, yet each observer can create their own interpretation, combining mudras and inventing personal meanings. Samyuktha becomes an immersive stage for discovery, where stilness and motion coexist, and the dance unfolds uniquely for every eye
